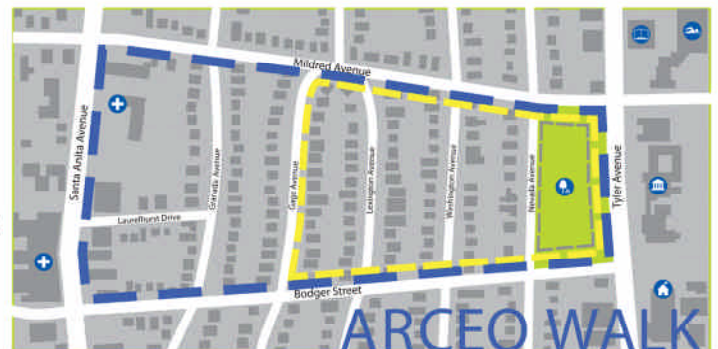

The City of El Monte Health and Wellness Initiative is a grant funded program through the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health. The City is developing a Health and Wellness Element for the El Monte General Plan, with proposed components addressing healthy lifestyles and physical activity, access to healthy food, public safety and security, and access to recreation.

The physical project of the Health and Wellness Initiative is to develop Arceo Walk, a 1 mile circuit walking path with mileage markers and signage connecting various civic, educational, retail and health care facilities in the area. The path is anchored by Arceo Park and bordered by Bodger Street, Tyler Avenue, Mildred Street and Santa Anita Avenue.
